He further added, "Furniture plays an extremely important part in the physical, moral and mental welfare of the students. However, many school children are deprived of this basic need. After providing mid-day meal, sanitation and other facilities to children, we are now focusing on

providing tables and benches so that learning could be fun, and children enjoy coming to school. We hope our small and sustained steps would make a big difference in their lives".

With the motto of Sustainable CSR, Havells India has employed carpenters at Alwar and Neemrana units who are continuously building durable tables and benches from the leftover wood at its plants. A similar program is also running at its Haridwar plant in Uttarakhand.
