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Safety Precautions

To prevent the risk of danger to humans or property damages, make sure to follow the precautions described below.

■ The descriptions are classified according to the degree of harm or damage caused by misuse.



WARNING May cause serious injury or death.

WARNING

■ For Power Plug and Cord

Prohibited matters

(To prevent fire or electric shock)

- Do not damage, modify, immoderately bend, twist, pull, or bundle them. Do not put them close to heating appliances. Do not put anything heavy on them.
- Do not connect/disconnect them with wet hand.
- Do not hold the cord when pulling out of the socket.
- Do not use a damaged cord and power plug. Also, do not use them when the socket is loose.

Matters to be observed

(To prevent fire or electric shock)

- Use a socket solely that satisfies the rating requirement. (Using in combination with other appliances could cause fire.)
- Insert the power plug all the way seated.
- Wipe the plug periodically with dry cloth. (Accumulated dust collects moisture, which may cause insulation failure, resulting in fire.)
- Pull out the cord before cleaning or when not used for a long period of time.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.

In case of emergency or operation failure, stop using the washing machine immediately and pull out the power plug.

(To prevent fume, fire or electric shock)

- No operation even at power on, accumulated dust and moisture on the power plug, abnormal sound in operation, burnt odour, etc.

→ Consult a service person for inspection and repair immediately.



■ For Tub and Main Unit

Do not allow children to use alone.

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Never disassemble, repair or remodel.

(To prevent fire or abnormal operation, resulting in injury.)

Keep fire away from the main unit.

(To prevent fire)

Do not touch the tub until it completely stops.

(Your fingers may be entangled in the laundry even during slow rotation, resulting in injury.)

If the tub does not stop within 15 seconds when the lid is opened during spin cycle, switch off the washing machine immediately and call a service person.

Do not splash water over the washing machine. Do not install at a damp place or a place which may be exposed to rain, water, etc.

(To prevent electric shock or fire)

- Balcony, bathroom, etc.

Make sure to provide a ground.

(To prevent electric shock by short circuit)

- Ask a service person for grounding.

Part Name

■During Use

Do not put in flammable things or clothes with such things attached. Keep them away from the washing machine.

(To prevent explosion or fire)

- Kerosene, gasoline, benzine/thinner, alcohol, etc.

Keep away magnetic objects such as magnet from the operation panel.

(The tub may rotate even with the lid open, resulting in injury.)



CAUTION

Do not wash, rinse, or spin waterproof sheets and clothes.

(Intense vibration during spin or falling of the machine may result in injury, damages to the main unit, wall, floor, etc., damage to the laundry, water leakage, etc.)

- Raincoat, wet suit, diaper cover, car cover, waterproof sheet, etc.

Prohibited matters

- The new hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and the old hose-sets should not be reused.
- Do not insert your hand or foot under the main unit.
- (To prevent from getting caught in the rotation part,

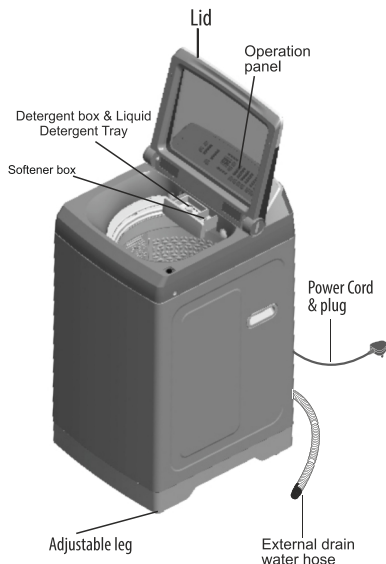
Do not climb up or put heavy things on the washing

If the lid is broken, stop using this machine immediately.

- (To prevent deformation and breakage, resulting in injury)
- Do not connect to a water heater or directly pour water of 60°C or more into the tub.
- (The plastic parts may be deformed, resulting in electrical leakage or electric shock.)
- Do not install at uneven or unstable locations.

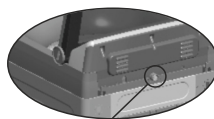

NOTE

- Normal wash course is recommended for a normally soiled load at the rated capacity of this washing machine.
- Insta wash is available with Normal, Mix Wash, Jeans, Eco wash.
- Heater is not available with swift 15 and delicate courses.
- For BEE star rating program, use Eco wash course at water level 10 with wash time 7 minutes, single rinse and spin of 7 minutes.
- Heater Performance may vary according to the ambient conditions and actual temperature may differ than the defined temperature settings.

Laundry preparation and check

For clothes easily losing colour,
Wash separately.



Pretreatment

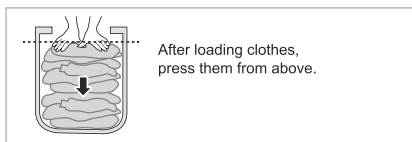
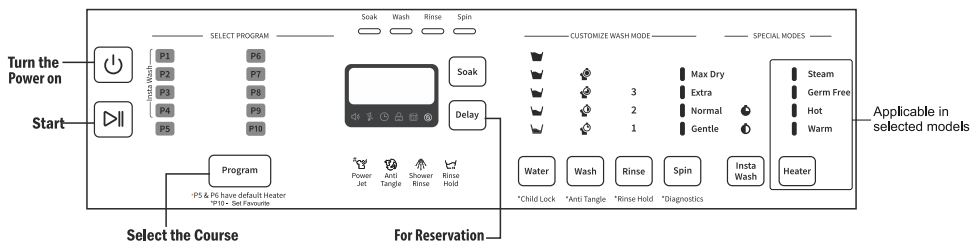

Washing

- Preparation: ●Check whether the washing machine has been properly installed.
●Turn on the water faucet.



1 **turn the power on.**

2 According to the water level, **put in the detergent.**
(Follow the instruction described on each detergent's container.)



3 **Close the lid.**

4 According to the type of laundry and soil, **Select the course**
(e.g.) Normal Wash course

■For reservation

After selecting the course, select how many hours later you wish to complete the entire operations.



- After reservation is set
- Change or cancel
→ Press "Power" Off and do the procedure again.
- Check the course
→ Press "Program".
- Check the reservation time
→ Press "Delay".
- Check the water level
→ Press "Water Level".

■For water selection

Select the water level
*After start the operation child lock will be activated and deactivated by long press and hold Water for 5 second
*Some water levels are not applicable. with selected courses.

■For wash time selection

Press the button to select the different wash duration.
*Long press and hold to disable and enable the anti-tangle option for wash.

■For Number of Rinse selection

Press the button to set the number of Rinse for a cycle (From 1-3)
*Long press and hold to enable & disable Rinse Hold feature, water hold after the Rinse

■For Spin selection

Press the button to set the Spin time for an operation (from Gentle to Max Dry)
* Long press for error code diagnostics with help of Havells sync mobile application.

When water is not selected, the tub rotates without water and measure the load
(approx. 60 seconds)

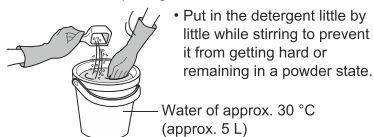

NOTE

- Turn the tub by hand if it is difficult to put out or put in the lint filter.
- In stain wash, anti-bacterial, quick courses are selected, the water level is displayed immediately.
- Program modes may vary according to the model.

NOTE

- When powdered detergent is poorly soluble, dissolve in warm water before putting in.



- If there are many thick or large clothes (jeans, sheets, etc.) in the tub, the detergent may remain undissolved. Dissolve the detergent according to the above method, or reduce the amount of laundry.
- If excessive bubbles form, reduce the amount of detergent or change the detergent.

Using softener

Put the softener in the softener inlet according to the water level indication.

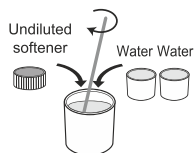
- Automatically added on the final rinse.
- To add in operation, press "Pause" first.



- Do not use a separated or solidified softener.
- Softener easily becomes hard. Do not leave in the softener compartment for many hours (12 hours or longer).

Concentrated type

Dissolve softener.



- Well mix** in another container before putting in. (To facilitate smooth flow)
- Follow each softener's instructions.

NOTE

- If "Pause" is pressed during spin cycle, the softener will be added too early and its effectiveness will decrease.
- The softener will not be added automatically if not put in by the time "Wash" cycle is complete.

Using Liquid Detergent

- Pour the liquid detergent in the liquid detergent tray.
- Do not use solidified liquid detergent.
- Liquid detergent easily becomes hard. Do not leave liquid detergent in the liquid detergent for many hours (8 hours or longer)

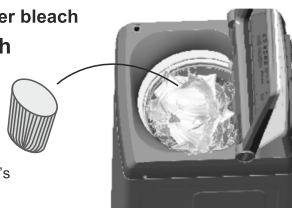


Using bleach

Oxygen powder bleach

Put the bleach in directly during water supply after start.

*Follow each bleach's instructions.



NOTE

- Do not use a bleach for **P9** Delicate Course
- Do not use a chlorine bleach for coloured and printed clothes. (Loss of colour may result.)
- If a chlorine bleach is used, wash the tub with **P9** Tub clean without bleach.

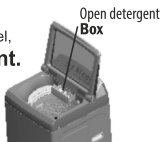

Preparation: Turn on the water faucet.

2 According to the water level, **put in the detergent.**
(Follow the instruction described on each detergent's container.)



3 **Close the lid.**

4  According to the type of laundry and soil, **Select P3 Jeans**



5  **Start.**

P8 Delicate

This course gently washes delicate clothes and stylish garments.

Load the laundry.

Put in the laundry evenly.



- First, put in things that easily float on the water, and press the laundry from above.
- Use a commercially sold net for delicate clothes.
- Amount of laundry that can be washed at one time is upto 3 kg at a time.


Preparation: Turn on the water faucet.

1  **Turn the power on.**

2 According to the water level, **put in the detergent.**
(Follow the instruction described on each detergent's container.)



3 **Close the lid.**

4  According to the type of laundry and soil, **Select P8 Delicate Course**



5  **Start.**

Insta Wash

Preparation: Turn on the water faucet.


1  **After loading the laundry, turn the power on.**

2  Select any Program from P1-P4 **Select P1 Normal Course**









3  **Select the insta wash**
Level 1 & Level 2 : Select according to wash time requirement

4  **After closing the lid, start.**


The operation is complete with the buzzer sound.

Default Heater temperature is 55° C . Default temperature can be changed by pressing Heater button.
- 6  Start.

NOTE

- Use a liquid detergent for stylish garments.
- Do not use a bleach.
- *Programs applicable only for Heater models.

P6 Anti-Bacterial

- **Clothes that can be dried**






 - Material: Synthetic fibre
 - Weight: 1.5 kg max.
- 1  turn the power on.
 - 2 According to the water level, **put in the detergent.**
(Follow the instruction described on each detergent's container.)
 Open detergent Box
 - 3 Close the lid.
 - 4  Select P6 Anti-Bacterial

 - 5  **Temperature Setting**
Default Heater temperature is 60° C. Default temperature can be changed by pressing Heater button.
 - 6  Start.

NOTE

- The laundry may not be sufficiently dried depending on the amount of the load, type of clothes, temperature, and installation condition of the washing machine.

Wash/Rinse

Preparation: Turn on the water faucet.

- 1  After loading the laundry, **turn the power on.**
- 2 According to the purpose,
 Unselect Rinse and Spin operation.
 Unselect Wash and Spin operation.
• Change the water level as necessary.
- 3  After closing the lid, **start.**

The operation is complete with the buzzer sound.

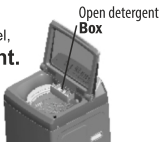

Convenient Functions

Spin

Preparation: Turn on the water faucet.

- 1  After loading the laundry, **turn the power on.**
- 2  Press Spin.
(By Default 7 Mins Spin)
To select other Spin Level
Press the Key again.
- 3  After closing the lid, Press **Start**
⋮
The operation is complete with the buzzer sound.

Cancelling end buzzer

-  Press  Press and hold for 3 seconds.
- To reset, do the same procedure.
- 

Setting Child Lock

If the lid is opened during operation with this function activated, the buzzer continues to beep with E03 error on the display until the lid is closed.

Power on/off will be operational in child lock mode
all other function will be locked.

(To prevent children from falling in the tub and drowning)

- This function does not lock the lid and Power button operation.
- Set the drain hose in the condition where water can be drained.

When machine is in On condition and washing is going on then press water for 3 seconds and child lock will be activated

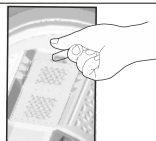

Maintenance

Lint filter

After each operation

- 1 Hold the upper part and remove.



- 2 Open the filter and remove the lint.

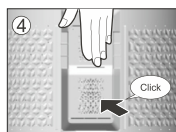


- If removal is difficult, soak the filter in water and wash.



Attach to the original position.

NOTE

- Do not wash laundry with the filter removed.
(To prevent damage to clothes)

■If removing the filter is difficult

Turn the tub. (See left.)

■If the filter is broken

Buy a new filter at nearest Lloyd Service Centre.

When Necessary

Water supply filter

If water does not flow smoothly

- Make sure to observe the following procedure to prevent spatter of water.

- 1 Turn off the faucet.** 
- 2  Turn the power on.**
- 3  After closing the lid, start.**
- 4  After approx. 40 seconds, turn the power off.**
- 5 Loosen the nut.** 
- 6 Remove the hose and water supply filter.** 
- 7 Remove the dust of water supply filter.** 

Main unit/Lid

If detergent or softener stains are found

Wipe with a soft cloth.

(To prevent damage to resin or metal corrosion)

- For heavy soil, use a neutral detergent for kitchen and wipe off.
- (Do not use other detergents or directly pour water.)

Tub Clean

Tub Clean Reminder

After operation is complete,









When it needs to clean the drum, Machine will give the Alarm for it, selected model Clean program.



When Tub Clean is due after 50 cycles, this icon will glow. Once you run the Tub Clean program, It will turn off the glow of the icon.

Once a month (Wash)

Preparation: Turn on the water faucet.

- 1  Turn the power on without laundry in the tub.**
- 2  Select P9 Tub clean course.**

- 3  Start.**
- 4  When water supply is complete, pause.**
- 5 Put the Puro Clean Descaling powder in the tub.** 
Approx. 200 ml
- 6  After closing the lid, start.**

The operation is complete after approx. 1 hours.

When Necessary

Installation

■ If the installation, test run and inspection of the washing machine are not carried out following this installation method, Lloyd will not be liable for any accident or damage caused.

■ Make sure to ask a service person for installation. Do not install by yourself.

1. Check the installation location.

■ Avoid the following locations for installation.

- Locations where there is a possibility of freezing.
- Locations exposed to direct sunlight
(To prevent malfunction or deformation)
- Uneven or unstable locations
(on blocks, timbers, table with wheels attached, etc.)

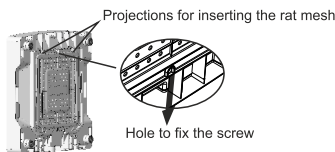

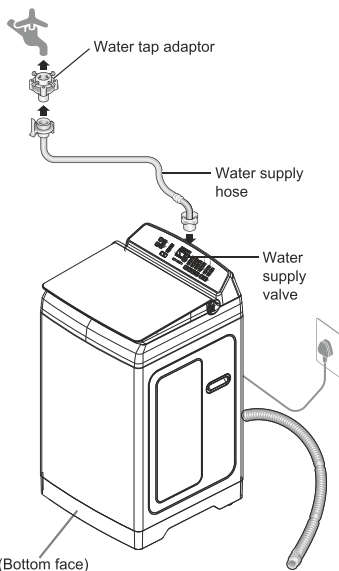
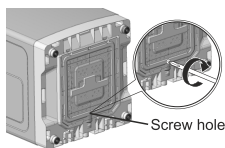
2. Attach the Anti-Ratmesh

Preparation: Set a cardboard, etc. and lay the washing machine on it, avoiding product damage and deformation. (Face the front side down.)

1 Insert along the guides, and set 2 holes to the corresponding projections.



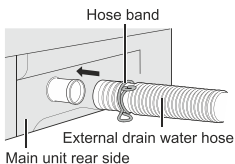

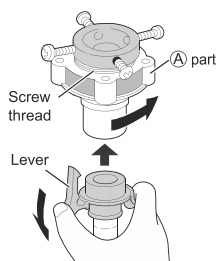

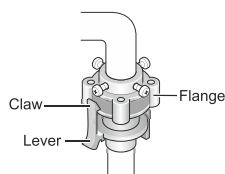

- Slightly lift up the elbow and tighten the nut.
- Check if the elbow is not loose.

- Tighten the nut firmly.
(To prevent water leak)
- Do not forcibly bend the water supply hose.
(To prevent water leak caused by the bent hose)

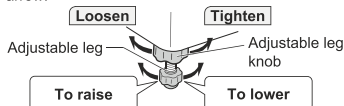
5. Connect the power plug and grounding wire.

- Ask a service person for grounding work.

6. Check the horizontal state.

■ Adjusting height with the adjustable leg knob.

- 1) Turn the adjustable leg knob to the left side and loosen as indicated with the left pointing arrow. Then, turn the adjustable leg to adjust the levelness.
- 2) Turn the adjustable leg knob to the right side and tighten securely as indicated with the right pointing arrow.



■ Level indicator

7. Perform a trial operation.

- Check if there is no water leakage, abnormal sound or error messages.

The appliance is intended for Domestic/Household use only and not for any similar applications such as:

- a) staff kitchen area in shops, offices and other working environments.
- b) farm houses.
- c) by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments.
- d) bed and breakfast type environments.
- e) areas for communal use in blocks of flats or in launderettes.

Troubleshooting

Check the following before requesting service.

B. Warranty Terms & Conditions:

1. To claim Warranty, it is mandatory that the customer provides the original invoice and wherever possible original Warranty certificate (duly signed and stamped by the selling dealer) must be presented by the customer.
2. To claim warranty service, customer needs to log in his complaint with the customer care cell.
3. This Warranty is limited to the first purchaser of the Product only.
4. This Warranty is valid and applicable only in respect of the Product purchased in India only.
5. This Warranty cannot be clubbed with any promotional limited warranty scheme prevalent on the date of the invoice unless specifically provided for in any special Warranty schemes.

7. The Warranty period specified above shall include the period when the Product is not in use, time taken for repairs, replacements, breakdowns, transit time, etc. No notice of expiry period of Warranty will be given by the Company.
8. It is clarified that after one year from the date of invoice, Company's responsibility to continue to provide additional Warranty services in terms as agreed upon shall however be limited only to supply of the parts free of cost and any cost(s) incurred towards labor, transportation and any other incidental expenditure for providing the said Warranty services shall be borne by the customer
9. The decision to repair or replace any part of the product shall be at the sole discretion of the Company. In the event of repairs or replacement of any part carried out during the said Warranty Period, the Warranty shall thereafter continue only for the unexpired period of the Warranty.

14. Thereafter the customer shall transport the Product to the new location at his own cost and consequences for re-installation of the Product. The customer shall again log in the request with customer care cell for such re-installation which shall be undertaken by Company's Authorized Service Representative. Such dismantling and re-installation, undertaken during the Warranty period shall be done on chargeable basis. Any damage to the Product caused on account of such transit shall be at customer's cost and risk and Company shall not be held responsible in any manner whatsoever.
15. In case of any additional warranty offered by the Company on the Motor on the date of purchase/invoice, the Company shall be responsible to only supply the motor free of cost to the customer and any cost(s) incurred towards labour, transportation, & any other incidental expenditure shall be borne by the customer.
16. The Warranty provided herein is in lieu of implied conditions and warranties under the law and is confined to the repair or replacement of defective parts and does not cover any economic loss, commercial loss, consequential or resulting liability, damage to the property, or any other harm or loss.
