This Policy outlines our expectations and requirements for suppliers to operate in an environmentally responsible manner.

This policy applies to all relevant suppliers, contractors, and business partners engaged in providing goods, services, or materials.

Our Commitments

- We will actively engage with suppliers to promote environmental best practices and provide support and resources to help them improve their sustainability performance.
- We will ensure and prioritize sourcing raw materials from sustainable sources.
- We will promote the use of recycled raw materials in our products and processes without compromising on product quality and performance.
- We will participate in and support initiatives that promote sustainable supply chain practices and engage with industry groups, non-governmental organizations, and other stakeholders to share knowledge and best practices for sustainable sourcing.
- Suppliers must comply with all applicable local, national, and international environmental laws, regulations, and standards.
- Suppliers are encouraged to minimize resource consumption, such as energy, water, and raw materials, and to implement measures to improve efficiency in their operations.
- Suppliers should adopt waste reduction, recycling, and responsible disposal practices. Minimization of hazardous materials and promotion of product life cycle management are also expected.
